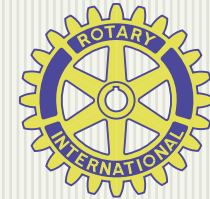

## KCS EXPANDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS



Kannapolis City Schools is continuing to expand the opportunities that it offers to students. During the 2017-18 school year, KCS added magnet programs in A+ Arts, Global Studies, and Spanish Language Immersion. All of those programs are open to

elementary students living anywhere within the KCS district, which means more options for students and their families. KCS also has added other innovative programs at the elementary level, including Classrooms of Tomorrow, Real School Gardens, and Learn Well/Live Well. At the middle and high school levels, KCS has added courses in Engineering, Information Technology, and Graphic Design that give students broader options. KCS students can complete apprenticeship programs during high school and have guaranteed job offers as soon as they graduate. Apprenticeship students also are eligible to receive scholarships that allow them to attend college for free.

KCS is finding other ways to expand Career Technical Education programs. For example, students can now take courses in the areas of public safety, and they will soon have the chance to be trained in advanced manufacturing. In addition, KCS students are earning certifications in the fields of welding, internet technology, nursing fundamentals, and more. During the 2017-18 school year, KCS students earned \$2.5 million in college scholarships, and many entered high paying jobs right out of high school thanks to completing apprenticeship programs or earning career certifications in high school.

KCS will continue to offer these life changing opportunities for students at all levels and will work to add more options in the years to come. Having the support of the community to build these programs is vital, and KCS is extremely grateful for the support of the Kannapolis Rotary Club in giving our students even more opportunities to succeed.
