TODAY'S ROTARY PROGRAM: ZACHARY MORETZ



Our Speaker today will be Zachary Moretz from the Moretz Law Group. Zac is the Rotarian of the year from the Concord club. He will be sharing with us some information about the annual Canathon, which began in 1980. Zac has chaired the event since 2010. He has also served as a Director, and is a Paul Harris Fellow.

Zac is founding partner and president of Moretz Law Group, which he originally started in 2003. He is a Certified Specialist in Commercial Real Estate Law by the North Carolina State Bar, and is also a licensed real estate broker. He practices in the areas of commercial real estate law, business law, homeowners association law and motorsports law.

Prior to law school, Zac was a product manager in the consumer software industry in Atlanta, and most notably was in charge of product development and marketing for UnInstaller, the world's best-selling business software title during the early 1990's. He is also a former SCCA national championship road racer - his throttle cable snapped on the back straight at Road Atlanta while running second for the national championship in the F Production class in 1994.

Zac has served on the boards of directors of Concord Rotary Club, Concord Downtown Development Corp., Historic Cabarrus Inc., and the Historic Preservation Foundation of North Carolina, and as a

member of the City of Concord Historic Commission. He enjoys racing go karts, playing lacrosse, road biking, water skiing, historic preservation and reading. Zac is a native of Sanford, North Carolina and is a graduate of Ravenscroft High School in Raleigh, Oglethorpe University in Atlanta, and Wake Forest University School of Law.
